

AMS 2020 Ursula Thrush Peace Seed Grant Application

The American Montessori Society Peace & Social Justice Committee awards annual Peace Seed Grants to help fund projects that promote peace education. The grants are presented in memory of educator Ursula Thrush, whose dedication to the concept of peace through children inspired many to advance peace education and social justice in their classrooms and communities. Grants range between \$100 and \$1,000.

Requirements: Application must be no longer than 3 pages. All grant recipients will be required to submit a report, including pictures, for potential sharing with the greater AMS community.

Projects must be completed by February 1, 2021. If project is not completed by the deadline, funds must be returned to AMS.
